Come join our new Study program - our Partnership Series! Come join us from beginning to end, and experience all that we enjoy teaching as Ken McNabb Certified Master Trainers!

You will be working in partnership with your horse through all the training. We have studied and currently teach in conjunction with our Ken McNabb certification process. Enjoy what you are learning, reach your horsemanship goals, and create an unforgettable "Partnership" with your horse!

Your horse may enjoy living in the barn while you work your program, or you can haul in weekly for your studies. Don't have a horse? Let us help you find one!!!! Check in to our "Retrain a Rescue" rates.

Each program is designed for owner-trainer study for a minimum of 6 hours weekly, including a private lesson and practice time, over a 3-month study period. You may work at your own pace and challenge the graduation demonstration requirements at any time, and proceed to the next level!

1. Groundwork: (The first series)

Natural horsekeeping, round pen basics, brushing, ground tying, controlling emotions with sacking out, riding the horse you lead, starting your lateral maneuvers from the ground, line work outside the round pen.

- ▶ Graduating with a loose line or liberty ground maneuvers demonstration

2. First Saddling - Foundation in the Saddle:

Equipment, saddling, bridling, riding from the side, perfecting your lateral maneuvers from the ground, in-depth development for softness in the bridle, rope and more emotional work, mounting, finding your gas pedal, brakes and steering wheel for your first 50 rides.

- ▶ Graduating with accomplishments from your first 50 rides

3. Advancing Your Groundwork:

Bathing, clipping, trailer loading, line work over obstacles, introduction to hobbling, bodywork for the athlete.

- ▶ Graduating with horse keeping demo, trail in hand, trailer loading demo

4. Advancing Your Riding Maneuvers:

Lateral maneuvers, spins, rollbacks, posting the trot, haunches in, Figure 8 lead changes, stopping, sidepass and back up on a loose rein, preparation for bridleless work, control of the body parts, cowboy dressage.

- ▶ Graduating with walk, trot, lope, demo of control with softness, cowboy dressage pattern

5. Introduction to Life:

Preparation for trail, riding out on the trail, ranch work, introduction to cattle, applying your horsemanship to your riding goals, giving lessons to others (if desired), clinic preparation and off-ranch study.

- ▶ Graduating with control on the trail, working outside the barn, teaching a lesson, riding a clinic (if desired).

6. Introduction to Driving:

Equipment, preparation and work to introduce your horse to harness and cart, safety and guidelines for driving.

- ▶ Graduating with single man hitch, drive
